

Answers: Understanding standard drinks

- 1** Glass A has more alcohol, because wine has a higher alcohol content than full strength beer.
- 2** Glass B has more alcohol, because 30ml of spirits is 1 standard drink while a glass (around 285ml) has 0.6 standard drinks.
- 3** 30ml spirit: 2
- 4** 375ml can of high strength pre-mixed spirits: 0.5
- 5** 275ml full strength pre-mixed spirits: 1
- 6** 100ml of wine: 2
- 7** 375ml bottle of low strength beer: 2.5
- 8** One can of full strength beer is = 1.4 standard drinks
- 9** 700ml bottle of spirits is = 22 standard drinks
- 10** 330ml high strength alcoholic soda is = 1.8 standard drinks
- 11** 3 cans of full strength beer are = 4.2 standard drinks
- 12** 30ml spirit is = 1 standard drink
- 13** A 375ml can of full-strength beer has 1.4 standard drinks in it.
- 14** A 330ml bottle of high-strength alcoholic soda has 1.8 standard drinks in it.
- 15** A six pack of full-strength beer has 8.4 standard drinks in it.
